Position details:

St Joseph's School, Boulder, is a single stream primary school located in the town of Kalgoorlie-Boulder. We have a young, dynamic and dedicated staff and are looking for a teacher for our Year 3 class to join the team in early Term 3 with a start date to be negotiated. There is a strong likelihood that this position will continue into 2023 and become ongoing.

Kalgoorlie-Boulder is a very large town, with a population of almost 30,000. There is a wide range of activities available for both adults and children. We enjoy the additional benefits of the CEWA Remote Area Package, such as rental assistance and **there is currently housing available for the successful candidate**. We are just an hour's flight from Perth and the Prospector train also provides a daily service. Once here, you will not want for much as Kalgoorlie-Boulder is extremely well-resourced and vibrant, with a huge choice of places to eat, a range of sporting clubs to join, parks and open spaces, a movie theatre and a modern recreation centre. You could also enjoy weekend breaks in Esperance.

We enjoy high levels of parent satisfaction and a close relationship with the parish. Selection criteria:

- Superior teaching skills and evidence of an excellent understanding of the plan-teach-evaluate-plan cycle
- Sound and consistent behaviour management approaches
- Excellent interpersonal skills and a high level of emotional intelligence
- A willingness to follow the school's established literacy and numeracy approaches
- The ability to be flexible, adaptable and to work in a team-focused environment
- A mindset focused on professional growth, personal development and getting out of your comfort zone
- An understanding of and the ability to differentiate the teaching and learning program to cater for a variety of student needs

Qualification required:

- A four-year teaching qualification (if the final practicum has been completed, but the degree is not quite finished, the school will consider applying for a Limited Authority to Teach)
- Accreditation to Teach in a Catholic School is preferable, but not required. If no accreditation is completed yet, a willingness to acquire this is essential.
