YEAR 6 LEAVERS SHIRTS

As part of their final year at primary school, Year 6s can wear their leavers shirt twice a week: on days when all students wear their green school polo shirt and on sports days or events.

SHOES

Formal Uniform:

All black flat formal school sandals, shoes or all black joggers are acceptable. There is to be **NO** white or other colour emblem on joggers. White soles are **NOT** permitted.

Canvas, high-tops, converse shoes etc. are NOT appropriate school wear shoes



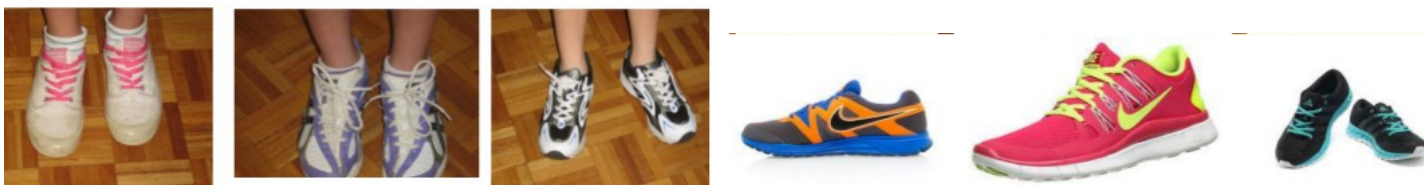
Sports Uniform:

Predominantly black or white low-cut joggers with matching black or white laces are acceptable. Coloured emblems are permitted on shoes for sport days only, i.e. NIKE & ASICS.

GROOMING FOR BOTH GIRLS AND BOYS

Hair should be neat and tidy and should not reflect the extremes of any current fashions. It must be trimmed above the eyebrows and kept free of the face. Hair that extends below the collar or long enough to be tied up, must be tied back with an elastic band, ribbon or scrunchie in the school colours - yellow and green – or in a colour matching the child's hair (eg. dark hair should use black, or dark brown elastics and blonde hair should use white, or light brown).

It would be impossible to list all inappropriate hairstyles and colours, so we ask parents to support the school by ensuring their child's appearance aligns with our guidelines. Acceptable hairstyles and colours are at the discretion of the principal. While some tips and highlights may be added, they should enhance the natural colours. Bright colours, such as pink etc., will result in the child being sent to the office to await collection by their parents and rectify the problem before their return to school.

SCHOOL HAT

St Joseph's is a SunSmart WA school member, and it follows 'no school hat, no play' to align with our Sun Safety Policy. It is mandatory for all children in Pre-Primary to Year 6 to wear the school hat. Additionally, we ask that students **DO NOT** share 'spare' hats with others as a hygiene measure.

JEWELLERY FOR BOTH GIRLS AND BOYS

No jewellery may be worn, except for simple earrings, a simple functional watch, and a simple necklace/chain with a religious pendant.

A maximum of one piercing per ear is acceptable with plain gold or silver sleepers or studs, as shown below.

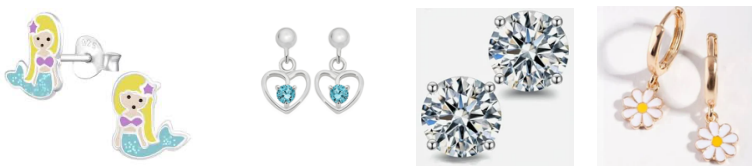
Please note: fashion jewellery is not appropriate as part of the school uniform. Students will be asked to remove any inappropriate earrings, necklaces and bracelets and they will be sent home in a zip-lock back.

Facial piercings are not permitted and would see the child sent to the office to await collection by a parent to rectify the problem before their return to school.

NAIL POLISH

Only clear nail polish can be worn by students from Pre-Primary to Year 6.

GLOVES & SCARF

On cold days, children may wear a **BLACK** scarf and/or gloves during recess and lunch time.

UNDERGARMENTS

Students are encouraged to wear appropriate undergarments for comfort and modesty beneath their uniform, such as singlets, long-sleeve t-shirts, bike shorts etc. Wherever possible, these garments should not be immediately visible (other than long-sleeves) and must be either **BLACK, WHITE or SKIN TONE** colours.

WINDBREAKERS

Fleece lined windbreaker jackets may be worn as an addition to the regular uniform for outdoor play/transit.

Please note: this windbreaker IS NOT to be worn in place of the uniform jumper, and students will not be permitted to wear them indoors.

COMMUNICATION

In the event of a student not wearing the appropriate uniform, please contact the class teacher with the following information:

- What the known uniform issue is (e.g. incorrect school shoes)
- What steps have been taken to resolve the issue (e.g. shoes ordered, waiting for delivery to Kalgoorlie)
- The expected date of resolution (e.g. should be delivered by the XX/XX/2024)

Teachers will contact families by SeeSaw or email if a student is wearing the incorrect uniform without prior notification. It is expected that any uniform issues will be corrected within a week, or that the above communication process is followed. Jewellery, nail polish and incorrect hair adornments worn for more than 1 day after notification will be removed by administration staff at school.
